Scope of Services

- Tendering and contract award for construction works concerning village irrigation fields and intake structures
- Tendering and contract award for supplier works concerning village motor pumps, spare parts, storage facilities, wells, etc
- Supervision of works and services, acceptance of works and services
- Negotiations with World Food Program (PAM) about distribution of food for work for villages concerned (in time supply of the quantities required by the population)
- Management of project logistics
- International procurement of pump repair and maintenance garage in Diré, management and equipment procurement of 4 branch offices, local procurement of pinnaces and ferries
- Organisation of beneficiaries' contribution
- Support to the management of pump repair and maintenance garage in Diré, management of pump spare part disposal system
- Management of trust accounts (for rice and pump spare parts)
- Financial management and accountancy, inter alia disposition fund accounts and funds of other donors
- Preparation of replenishment request for disposition funds
- Reporting of activities

Brief Project Description

Consulting services for the implementation of the project component Small Scale Irrigation Projects in the Niger Inland Delta (IPRODI) in the frame of the “National Small Scale Irrigation Program” (PNIP).

The project is an integrated part of the German development program “Durable irrigation in agriculture in Mali”. Concretely it is part of the module “Support program for the sub-sector of small-scale irrigation” of the Technical Cooperation and of the module “Contribution to the implementation of the national small-scale irrigation program” of the Financial Cooperation.



The overall goal of the project is to contribute in a systematic way to the valorisation of the economic potential of the region of Timbuktu.

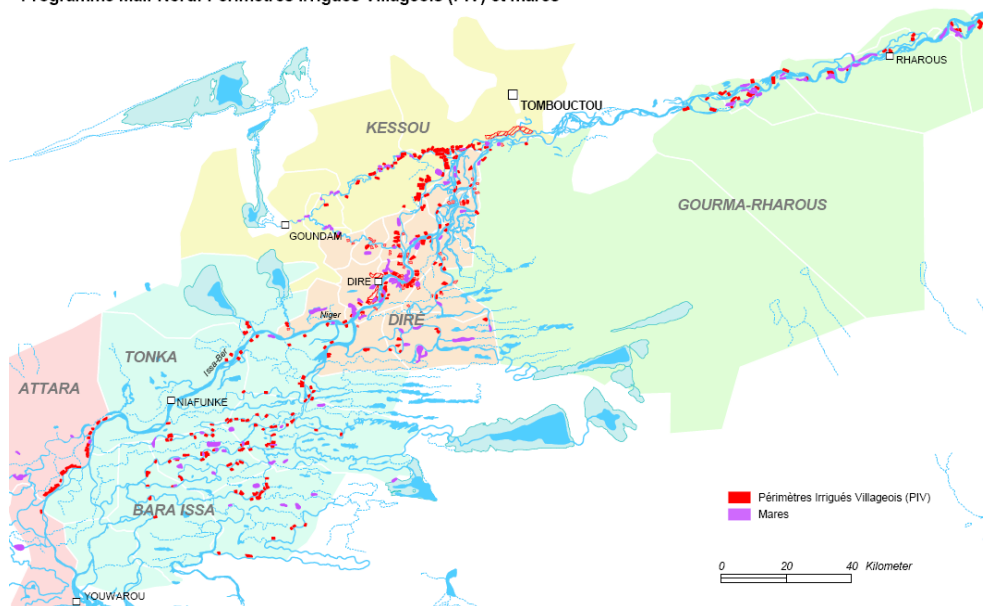
The project goal is: the valorised village irrigation fields and irrigation depressions are adapted to the ecologic and economic needs and they are cultivated in a durable way.



Concretely the activities concern:

- to promote dynamic local economic circuits, particularly to promote agricultural development by extending small-scale irrigation surfaces,
- to promote the creation of rural infrastructure and to support the development of an autonomous local administration,
- to promote and develop other economic activities and suppliers’ services besides small-scale irrigation or in its completion,
- to ensure by doing that the preservation of a fair ethnic balance and
- to contribute to peace stabilisation in the intervention zone.

Programme Mali-Nord: Périmètres Irrigués Villageois (PIV) et mares



The project’s objective should be achieved by a durable agricultural exploitation of the natural resources which are the soils and water in the irrigation fields. Another aspect is to provide earnings with reference to commercialisation and transformation of beneficiaries’ production.
