Brief Project Description

The Mariño micro-catchment contributes to the Río Pachachaca, it is located in the North-East of the Abancay Province being the capital of the Apurímac Region. The catchment covers an area of 228 km² with elevations ranging from 1 700 masl to 5 200 masl.

The project aims at improving the catchment's agricultural production capacities by means of integrated water and land use management. This shall contribute to better economical living conditions of the Abancay population and improve the ecological situation of the Mariño catchment.



The project embraces three components:

- Regional planning / Land use management
- Water resource management
- Institutional strengthening

Planning and coordination of these components are the main tasks of the Consultant.

The planning and project activities follow a participatory approach to closely involve beneficiaries and stakeholders.
